

By the end of Reception year we expect your child to be able to do the following:

### **Writing**

- use their phonic knowledge to write words
- write irregular common words – was, the, has etc
- write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others
- some words are spelt correctly and some are phonetically plausible.

### **Reading**

- read and understand simple sentences
- use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read them aloud accurately
- read some common irregular words – the, was etc
- demonstrate understanding when talking with others about what they have read

### **Maths-Number**

- Count reliably to 20
- Order numbers to 20
- Recognise numbers to 20
- Say a number which is one more or less than a given number
- Using objects add and subtract two single digit numbers
- Double a number up to 20
- Halve a number up to 20

### **Space, Shape and Measure**

- Compare size of objects
- Compare capacity of objects
- Talk about the position of objects
- Talk about distance
- Talk about time
- Recognise coins
- They recognise, create and describe patterns
- To identify and name 2d shapes and their properties
- To identify and name 3d shapes and their properties
