

**EYFS Medium Term Plan
Nursery Autumn 1 2022**

Week	Topic- Ourselves
5 th Sept	Home Visits
12 th Sept	Home Visits - Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday Settling in children in small groups for one hour with their parents, learning class routines, social skills for one hour sessions.
19 th Sept	Children to stay for two hours per day, without their parents. Begin to establish rules and routines. Focus Book and Rhyme: That's not my Polar Bear by Fiona Watt /Row Row Row Your Boat. Observations on PSED- how the children interact with each other and communicate. Focus on baseline assessments.
26 th Sept	Settling children into full sessions with the whole class, learning class routines, social skills, establishing key workers. Focus Book and Rhyme: Dear Zoo by Rod Campbell / Baa Baa Black/White Sheep Focus on baseline assessments L A and U and S Weekly focus-WR Choosing a reading book to take home. Each key worker reads with their child. Then that book will be taken home to share all week. Key worker letters to go out via Weduc
3 rd Oct	Weekly focus- EAD Painting pictures of Ourselves W- writing a speech bubble about what they enjoy at nursery and early mark making. Focus Book and Rhyme: Walking through the Jungle by Julie Lacome /Heads Shoulders Knees and Toes

10 th Oct	<p>Weekly focus- N Counting in order. Rote counting to 10, counting small groups of objects and recognising numbers. Observations to form evidence for baseline assessment.</p> <p>ICT- Using smart boards to colour in a picture. Finding letters in their name.</p> <p>Focus Book and Rhyme: Ten in the Bed by Penny Dale /If you're happy and you know It.</p>
17 th Oct	STEM week - Details to follow.

Baselining ongoing throughout the term. All evidence to be recorded as observations or with photographs to be placed in the child's journal.
