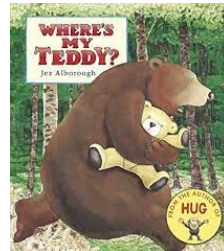
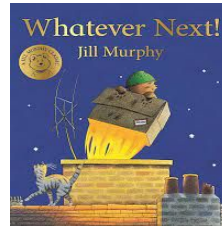
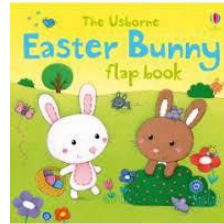
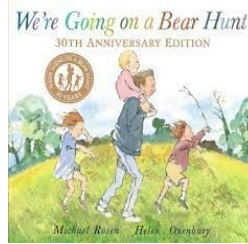
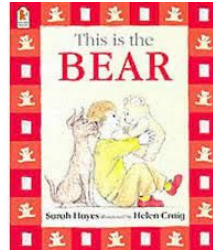


In this topic, **we are learning to:**

<b>spring</b>	The season after winter where it gets warmer and plants begin to grow.
<b>snowstorm</b>	When snow falls along with strong winds.
<b>cave</b>	An opening in a rock where the bear in our story lives.
