Vocabulary

occupations and jobs

An occupation is a job a person does. We will learn about roles people do at our school and how they are important to help the daily running of the school.

aspirations

Aspirations means that you have hopes and dreams for the future. We will find out more about job roles and ask the children what they aspire to be as they get older.

questions

A question is something we ask to find out more information. Children will be able to ask questions using the question words: who, what, when, where, why and how to find out more information.

environment

The environment is the area which surrounds us. The children will learn about our school and local environment.

oral health

Oral health is about the health of our teeth and gums. We can ensure good oral health by brushing our teeth.

healthy living and bodies

Healthy living means learning to eat healthy food and exercise our bodies as well as keeping our minds healthy.
